

Sugar Market Statistics



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SUGAR MARKET HIGHLIGHTS DELIVERIES

Sugar distribution for Continental consumption for the first quarter of 1988, totaled 1.9 million short tons, raw value, up 2 percent from a year ago. Sugar exports for January-March were 76,949 tons.

INVENTORIES

Sugar stocks held by U.S. primary distributors on March 31, 1988, totaled 3.5 million short tons, raw value, up 3 percent from last year.

DOMESTIC PRODUCTION

Sugar production for the Mainland United States for January-March 1988, totaled 2.0 million tons, raw value, up 4 percent from a year ago.

Hawaiian sugar production for the first quarter of 1988 totaled 111,805 tons, down 9 percent from a year ago.

IMPORTS

Receipts of raw imported sugar by U.S. cane refiners for January-March 1988 totaled 273,294 short tons, raw value, 28 percent below last year. Mexico with 45,746 tons and the Dominican Republic with 42,412 tons accounted for the largest and second largest tonnages.
